Council noted a report of the City Manager dated July 10, 1979 in which the City Engineer reported on subsequent procedure as follows:

"An area project on the 'Initiative Principle' has been advanced under the provisions of the Local Improvement Procedure By-law and will come before a Court of Revision on July 10, 1979.

The project is identified as follows:

Initiative 457	Kiwassa Area	Pavements Curbs Sidewalks

This project is eligible for a contribution from the Kiwassa Neighbourhood Improvement Program (N.I.P.) as approved by Council on March 6, and May 15, 1979. Cost sharing of the recommended \$75 167 N.I.P. expenditure will conform to the standard N.I.P. utilities formula as follows:

Federal	25%	\$18 791.74
Provincial	12.5%	9 395.88
City	62.5%	46 979.38
		<u>\$75 167.00</u>

CMHC has concurred with this allocation.

Capital Funds

Funds for the City's share of the cost of this project are available in already approved Capital budgets. Funds for the N.I.P. portion have already been allocated from the Kiwassa N.I.P. Accounts 891/8724 & 8728.

Recommendation

I recommend, subject to the proceedings of the Court of Revision and subsequent approval of Council, that:

- (a) The Kiwassa area project 'on the Initiative' - Schedule 457 be undertaken.
- (b) The project designated as 'other work' on Glen Drive from the lane south of Hastings to Georgia Street be undertaken."

The City Manager RECOMMENDS that the foregoing recommendation of the City Engineer be approved.

THAT the recommendation of the City Manager contained in his report of July 10, 1979 and quoted above be approved.


