The City Manager RECOMMENDS that the above recommendation of the City Engineer be approved.

Council also noted a letter from the Kensington Citizens Neighbourhood Improvement Program Planning Committee recommending the following:

- " 1. We urge you to approve all the sidewalk projects presented at the Court of Revision meeting of September 11, 1979;
- 2. We urge you to allocate more money in the 1980 budget for sidewalks by rearranging the Five Year Capital Plan and/or reallocating funds from the Supplementary Capital Budget. In the Five Year Plan Ballot sidewalks were one of the items that was approved;
- 3. We urge City Council to apply the 25% reduction that applies to pavement and curbs on major thoroughfares also to sidewalks on major thoroughfares and that the City initiate sidewalks on major thoroughfares in the same way that they initiate pavement and curbs and that if possible both be done at the same time. "

There being no delegations wishing to address Council on any of the projects, it was


MOVED by Ald. Marzari,


